Conditions of Entry

1. The Katoomba Quilt Show and Airing of the Quilts is open to **ALL** Quilter's and Patchworker's, regardless of location or skill level.
2. One entry form and the non-refundable \$5.00 entry fee are required for each quilt entered. A personal cheque, money order, credit card or cash is accepted. A photograph of each quilt is optional, but strongly recommended. One cheque for the total amount of entries fees may be used for multiple entries. On your entry form, choose one (1) entry category, this will be the category your entry is judged in. If you select multiple categories, only the first will be considered.
3. **The completed entry forms and fees must be received before 10th March 2010.**
4. Quilts entered in the Airing of the Quilts will be displayed outside on the building and grounds of The Stitching Post. If it is raining, the Airing of the Quilts will be cancelled.
5. It is recommended that each entry be insured by the entrant. The Stitching Post, volunteers or organisers are not responsible for loss or damage due to weather, theft, fire, vandalism or acts of God to any entry, display item, or associated material entered into the Quilt Show or Airing of the Quilts.
6. While we will endeavour to display all entered quilts, but reserve the right to hang as many entries as space permits. As this is a juried Quilt Show, selection for exhibition will be made by a committee and its decision will be final. Shapes other than squares or rectangles are discouraged and may not be displayed due to difficulty in hanging.
7. Each entry must have a fabric label attached to the bottom right hand corner of the back of the quilt. This should include at the minimum, the Entrant's Name.
8. Each entry must have a 4" wide fabric sleeve or rod pocket attached to the top of the back of the quilt for hanging. Quilts without a rod pocket will not be able to be displayed and as such will not be eligible for judging or prizes.
9. If entrant desires, the quilt may be sold to the public, a 15% commission will be withheld from the sale price. The sale price specified by the entrant must include this 15% commission. The entrant is responsible for any GST payable on the proceeds from the sale of the quilt less commissions. The Stitching Post is responsible for GST on the 15% withhold commission. All sale transactions are final and will be handled by The Stitching Post. Only cash or credit card will be accepted. If a quilt is sold, The Stitching Post will mail a cheque for the entrants specified sale price less commission within 1 week of the close of the show. The Stitching Post does not guarantee that an entry will be sold and the collection of any unsold quilts is the responsibility of the entrant. .
10. All entered quilts must be delivered between 10:00 am to 4:00 pm before 16^h March 2010. We are unable to accept deliveries outside of these hours. Entries will not accepted after 4pm 16^h March 2010, unless prior by prior agreement.
 - You can deliver your quilt in person to The Stitching Post at 100 Lurline Street Katoomba NSW 2780. You will receive a Confirmation of Entry which will be required to pick up your entry after the show.
 - Entries sent via the mail should be delivered to The Stitching Post, PO Box 267 Wentworth Falls NSW 2782. We recommend that your register your entry and that the quilt be placed in a disposable bag and mailed in a sturdy box. Include a stamped self-addressed envelope in the box to receive a confirmation of the receipt of your entry. This confirmation form will be required if you wish to pick up your quilt after the show.
11. No entries may be picked up before 5:00pm on 21st March 2010.
 - If you wish to pick your entry up, you can pick it up after the close of the show or from The Stitching Post. You must present a Confirmation of Entry or valid photo ID matching the Entrants name to pickup your entry. All entries must be picked up before the 31st March 2010. Any entries left after 1st April 2010 will be donated to local nursing homes.
 - If entry is to be returned by mail an additional fee of \$12.70 is required for each quilt entered. This fee includes postage, registration and insurance up to \$100.00. If entry is to be returned by mail, it will be mailed by 31st March 2010
12. Only The Stitching Post or certified volunteers will hang and take down all entries. Under no circumstances will an entry be taken down by any other person.
13. Quilt Frames and Displays are hired based on the measurements you provide in your entry form. These have to be ordered three weeks before the Quilt Show. Failure to correctly measure your quilts could result in your quilts not being displayed.
14. Entries in this years Quilt Show must not have been entered in last years Katoomba Quilt Show. Quilts displayed in other Quilt Shows can be entered.
